

Terms of Reference for the Chairs of the Science Themes and Working Groups

Responsibilities

- In consultation with the IIOE-2 Co-Chairs and subject to their final approval, select members of the Science Themes and Working Groups for the delivery of their area of activity based on the principles of professional qualifications and ability to deliver, geographical, age and gender balance;
- To chair the Science Themes and Working Groups, working mostly by electronic means;
- To plan, co-ordinate and monitor the activities of the Science Themes and Working Groups and focus them on delivery of the area of science or working group activity as outlined in the IIOE-2 Science Plan and Implementation Strategy;
- As a member of the Executive Board of the IIOE-2 Steering Committee (SC), to participate in SC meetings and to attend any face-to-face meetings (probably annually and for which resources will be provided, if available), representing their area of activity;
- To work with other members of the IIOE-2 Steering Committee including the Joint Programme Office (JPO) as required while also reporting and advising Co-Chairs of IIOE-2 SC.
